Contact details

Please ensure that the school office has three up to date telephone numbers and that we have an up to date address. This week we have had a couple of incidents where we have needed to phone a parent and the telephone number is no longer in use.

Free School Meals (FSM)

It has come to light that a few families may be eligible for free school meals. Please can we ask that you check with the office if you think you may be entitled. This is really important as the rules at the moment is that if you are on free school meals you will be able to receive FSM for a further four years even if your circumstances change. We understand that in KS1 and FS the school provides universal free meals we would ask you to still apply for the FSM at this time to ensure that the funding will continue for the four years. Please see the office if you are unsure.

School uniform

Please can you ensure that all clothing, coats and bags are labelled with your child's full name. Please could we also ask that you regularly check what clothing your child brings home because we have had a few reports of children going home with the wrong items this week thankyou.
