3p = 3 ones =




40p = 4 tens =



## Monday-English

Coordinating conjunctions join two simple sentences together, and we put a comma before the conjunction.

We use the conjunctions:

*and but so*

### Example:

It is sunny outside, *so* the children put on their hats.



## Monday-Science

# Creative Task


Monday
