
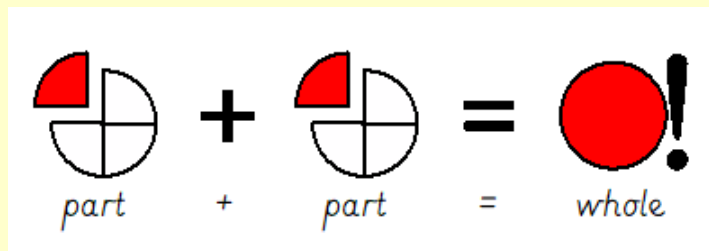









 A number bond to 10 is two numbers that join together to make 10.

 In number bonds to 10 the whole is always 10.

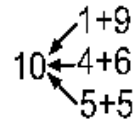

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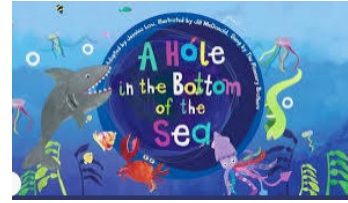
