












    
Money is what you use to buy things.

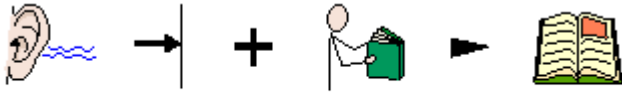
				

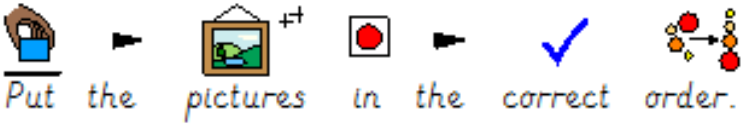
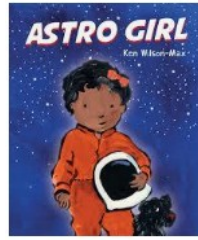
