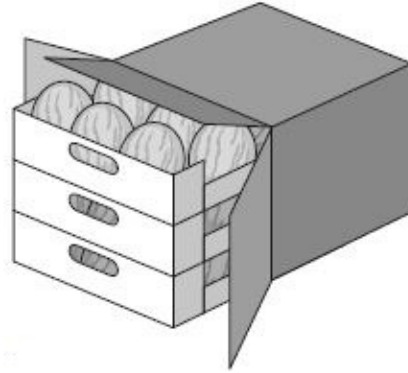

There are 3 trays in a box.

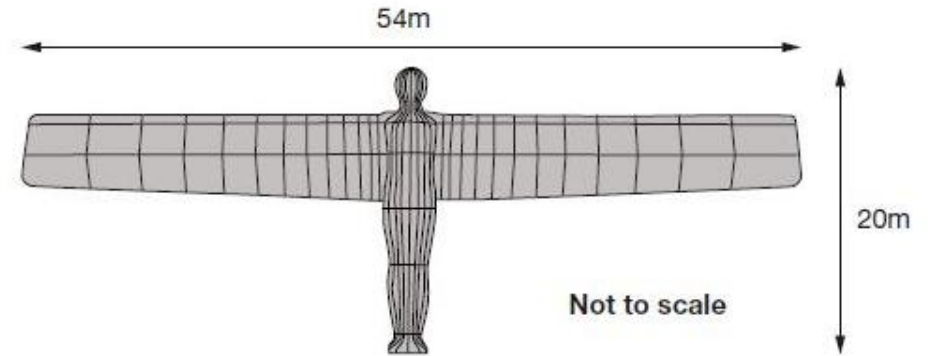


A supermarket sells **40** boxes of melons.
