AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS

EDUCATIONAL VISITS

- Used to do one every half term
- Based on topics – science, history, geography, art
- Costs have increased – especially coaches
- Tried to do 3 in a year
- Have now settled on 2 in a year

EDUCATIONAL VISITS

- Visits are necessary for the children's education – all children are taken
- Stretched budgets mean we can only subsidise children on Pupil Premium (Free School Meals) by 25%
- We try to give 4 weeks' notice to parents to give time to pay
- Parents are encouraged to pay in installments if necessary
- If the first visit doesn't get paid for, the second one would be cancelled
